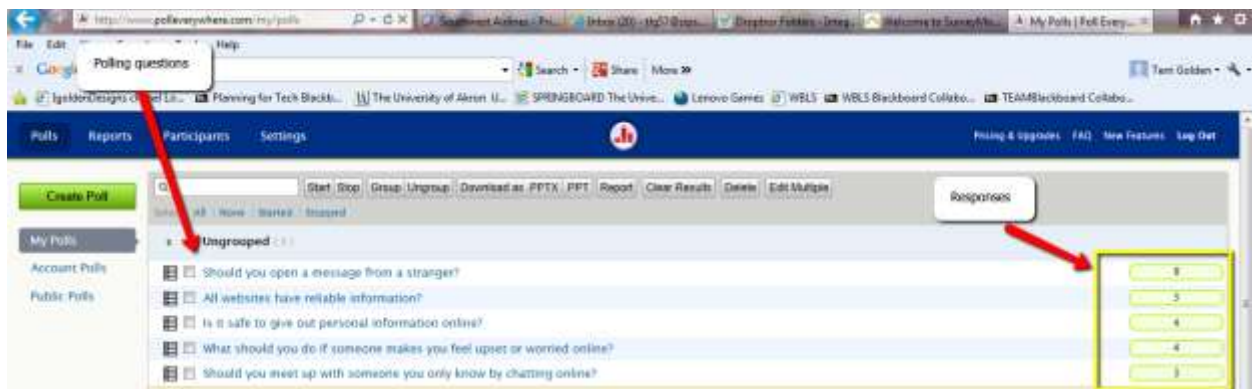


## Internet Safety Lesson Results

### Lesson Results

I presented the digital lesson plan on Internet Safety <http://gozips.uakron.edu/~tlg57/IITInternetSafety/IITInternetSafety.html> to the Teachers of Bethlehem Christian Academy on Monday, April 22 at the Teachers' meeting. 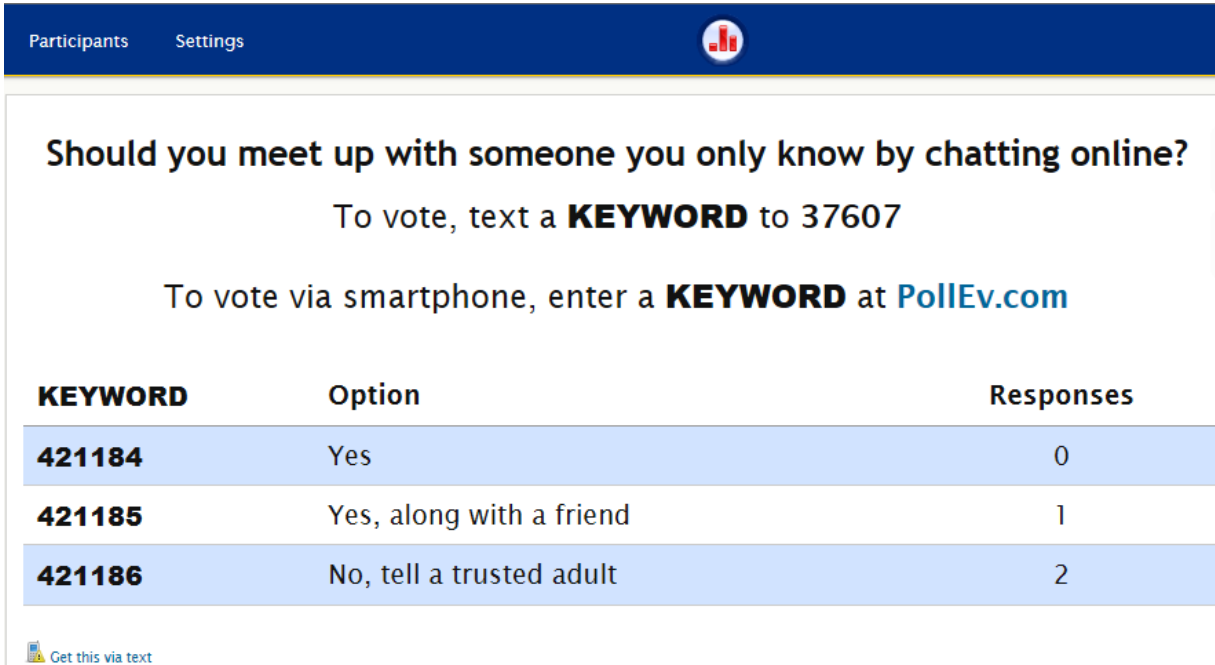
